Selma Historic Multi-Use Riverfront Trail, Phase I

ACCEPTANCE OF BID

Northwest Building Supply & Equipment Rental, Inc.

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) published an Advertisement for Bids in the Selma Times Journal and two regional newspapers to receive bids for the construction of the **Selma Historic Multi-Use Riverfront Trail, Phase I**; *and*

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received by the City of Selma at Selma City Hall, 222 Broad Street, Selma from the time solicited and closed at 11:00 a.m. on February 18, 2010, at which time the bids received were opened and read aloud; *and*

WHEREAS the appropriate officials of the City of Selma and the professional engineering firm, Gresham, Smith and Partners tabulated the bids and determined Northwest Building Supply & Equipment Rental, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bidder, said bids being certified by , Gresham, Smith and Partners; *and*

WHEREAS, the City desires to award Northwest Building Supply & Equipment Rental, Inc. the contract in the amount of \$261,871.00 for construction of the **Selma Historic Multi-Use Riverfront Trail, Phase I**, pending ALDOT approval, with the specifications provided by Gresham, Smith and Partners.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$261,871.00 for construction of the **Selma Historic Multi-Use Riverfront Trail, Phase I**, pending ALDOT approval, with the specifications provided by Gresham, Smith and Partners; *and*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED said contract expenses shall be encumbered via the ALDOT line item and funds will be reimbursed from ALDOT based on an 80/20 match requirement.


