APPOINTMENT OF PART-TIME MUNICIPAL JUDGE

Re-Appointment of Joseph Hagood, Esq.

WHEREAS, the City of Selma strives to provide and maintain a fair court system whereby the rights of due process, justice, certitude and human dignity of all of its constituency are upheld by the officers of the court as well as the promotion of propriety, diligence, and emends; *and*

WHEREAS, Ala. Code §12-14-30(a) provides that the governing body of the municipality shall, by a vote of a majority of its members, appoint judges of the municipal court; *and*

WHEREAS, the term of office of a municipal judge other than a full-time judge shall be two (2) years; *and*

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint a judge who possesses the qualifications, attributes, character, and assiduity required to perform the duties as required by Ala. Code §12-14-30; *and*

WHEREAS, Joseph Hagood, Esq. has demonstrated and been deemed as duly qualified and capable of serving as Municipal Judge; *and*

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to re-appoint Joseph Hagood to serve as a part-time Municipal Judge.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA BY VIVA VOCE VOTE AS FOLLOWS:

Joseph Hagood is hereby re-appointed as a Part-time Municipal Judge for the City of Selma and shall hold office for two (2) years;

Said term shall begin October 1, 2010 and end September 30, 2012 and shall continue until a successor has been appointed and qualified;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as judge, Joseph Hagood shall perform the duties in accordance with the Code of Alabama and the Selma Code of Ordinance.


